Financial Literacy in Marginalised Communities

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The activities of FLiMCo projects are ongoing and the partners are keeping working on its outputs in order to achieved expected objectives and results.

Virtual meetings as well as confrontations and brainstorming through project's platforms and communication channels are the working methods adopted since the COVID-19 pandemic began.

FLiMCo project partners are mostly working on the e-course on Financial Literacy for Marginalised Communities: it is composed by 12 modules concerning the most relevant themes and topics related to financial education, whose knowledge has important implications for empowerment and social integration for people who belong to marginalised communities.

FLiMCo's e-course on financial literacy will provide VET organizations and trainers with a useful training tool to and the project target groups (marginalised communities, refugees, NEETs) with the opportunity to increase their own financial literacy through an interesting, interactive and up to date e-course. It focuses on the real financial literacy needs of the above-mentioned groups.

Also, the piloting of the e-course and framework for financial literacy is currently taking place. The FLiMCo project Piloting Phase is focused on piloting the project outputs with the key stakeholders and target groups. This feedback will be summarised in a piloting feedback report and fed back into improvement, as well as the project's sustainability and exploitation plans.

The Financial Literacy in Marginalised Communities (FLiMCo) project successfully gained Erasmus+ funding in 2018. It aims to increase the financial literacy of marginalised, refugee and NEET youth communities who are at an increased disadvantage in day-to-day life due to their comparatively low level of financial literacy.
